A1 *Text in Action - Building Dynamic Performance (2 hours)*

Artistic Director for Fortune Theatre **JONATHON HENDRY** leads an intensive workshop especially for actors. Jonathon has worked at Toi Whakaari where he held the roles of Director of Actor Training(2013-15), Head of Acting/Associate Director (2000-2013) and Head of Acting (2007-2010). The Cabaret Club's **NEALE SMITH** gives practical advice in this hands-on workshop for directors and technicians. Neale has been involved in the entertainment scene for over twenty years, including playing in brass bands and pipe bands, and more recently behind the scenes directing and lighting for Invercargill Musical Theatre.



C1 & C3 *Special Effects Make-Up (1 hour)*

Halcyon Creative co-owner **KERRY PENISULA-SPAIN** shares some tricks of the trade, including how to age characters and creating scars and wounds. Kerry has extensive experience in the hair and make-up arena for theatre, television, and film. She was responsible for making the Phantom suitably hideous in Invercargill Musical Theatre's production of The Phantom of the Opera, and most recently headed the hair and make-up team for the Mary Poppins stage show.



D1 & D2 *Improvisation for Rehearsals (1 hour)*

Invers Theatre Company's **ANGELA NEWELL** teaches actors and directors games to encourage spontaneity in the rehearsal room. Angela has a wide range of theatrical experience--acting, directing, producing and writing. She established Shakespeare in the Park in Invercargill, and also programmes and manages the Southland Festival of the Arts in her role as Creative Projects Manager at Venture Southland.
